A College with a noble cause

The 35 successful and rewarding academic years that have gone by reaffirming our academic excellence through its valuable service in the field of higher education to empower the rural folk in and around the village Tholayavattam. Our College is administered by the Annai Velankanni College Administrative Board belongs to “*Friends of Kottar Society*”. Its primary intention is to provide quality education, mainly for the development of the socio economical and educational status of the economically backward rural people, without looking into their religion, caste, community or region. It is a Self-Financed College, which is recognized by the public and Government as a source of higher education. As on now the College is offering 10 UG Programmes, 8 PG Programmes, 6 Pre-doctoral (M.Phil.) Programmes and 7 Research (Ph.D.) Centres with an affordable cost.

Towards excellence in quality

The institution is blessed with 70 qualified and experienced teaching staff including 42 Ph.D. holders (more than 60%) and 29 M.Phil. degree holders with 42 Non Teaching Staff. Twenty seven of them are granted guideship approval by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. A total number of 118 Ph.D scholars are doing their Research in our Institution.

We are very happy to inform that our College has achieved a rare feat: Permanent University affiliation for 15 out of 18 courses: B.A. (Tamil), B.Sc. (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Biotechnology and Zoology) B.Com, B.B.A, M.A. (Tamil) M.Sc. (Chemistry, Physics, Biotechnology and Computer Science.) and M.Com.

Our College is the only first self-financed college in the district to acquire the 2(f) & 12(B) status by UGC and accredited with B++ by NAAC from 2016 onwards. We have submitted the *Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR)* for the year 2020-2021 on 23.03.2022.

Starting of the academic year

The academic activities of the College began with the re-opening on 9th August 2021 for the II and III year students and on 20th September 2021 for 1st year UG and PG students. These freshers were given general orientation.

Theme of the Year

Setting yearly theme for the year is like a guiding principle, an overarching outcome to work towards fulfilling the goal of the College. The theme for the academic year 2021-2022 is *“YEAR OF SPORTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS”*. As per the theme potential boys and girls were picked up from each department and special coaches were employed to coach the willing students. Accordingly daily coaching was conducted for Athletics, Kho-Kho and Kabaddi in the mornings and evenings. The students after coaching were being dropped in the nearby stations by college bus.

Students were encouraged to participate in all the District level, University and State level tournaments. Based on the theme of this year an Athletic Track was formed and opened on 15.02.2022 and District level inter-collegiate Athletic meet was hosted on the same day. On 22.02.2022 an inter-school Athletic meet was held. On behalf of Manomaniam Sundaranar University the inter-collegiate Kho-Kho match for boys and girl were hosted by our College in this academic year.

The athletes and football players of this college are undergoing training to compete for the Tamilnadu Chief Minister's Trophy Tournament announced by the Government.

Our College is being approved with B.Sc. Physical Education course. Hence a building to accommodate the Department of Physical Education is being built.
