Study Tour/Industrial Visit

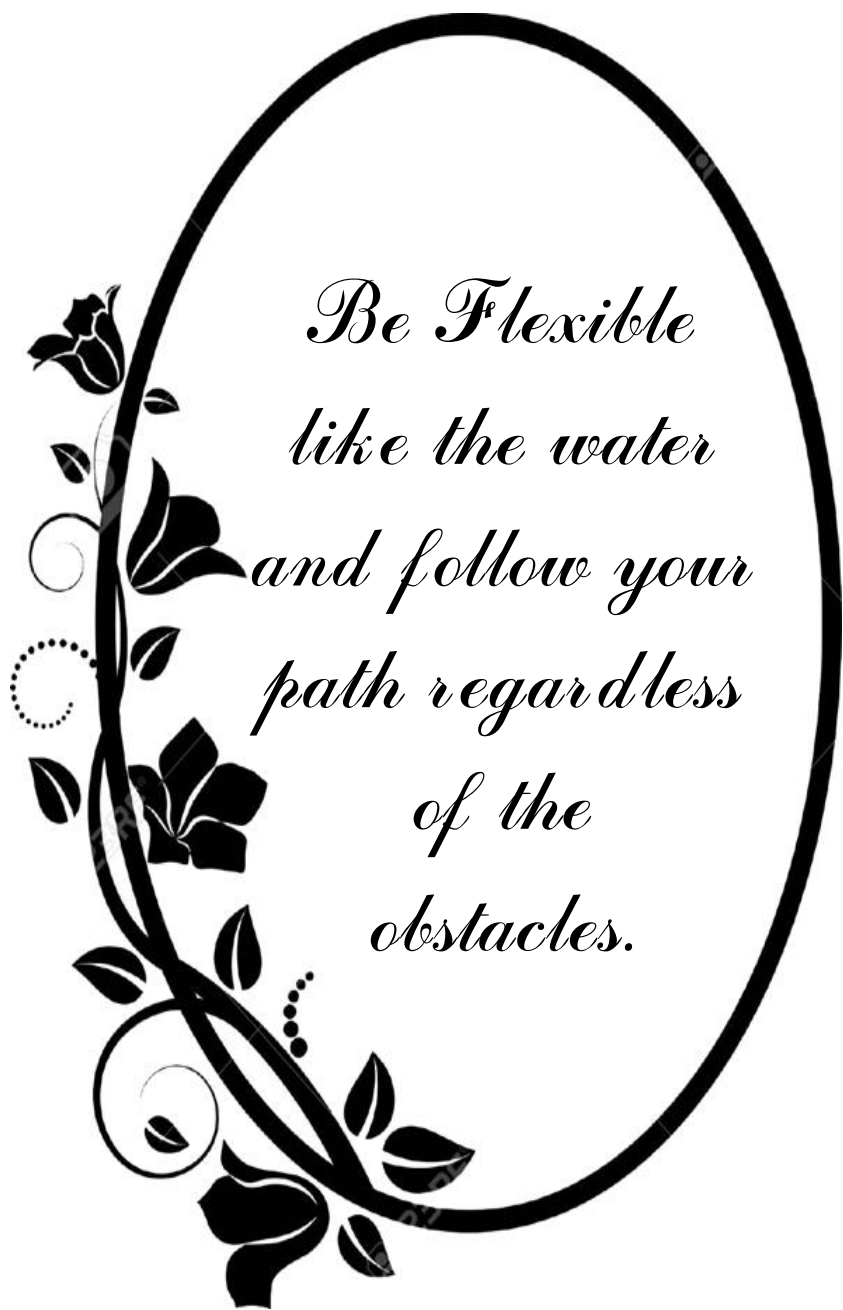
The College makes it compulsory to conduct department wise industrial visit relevant to their subject and study tour for all the final year students every year.

UNDER GRADUATE COURSE

The duration of study for U.G. course is 3 years (6 semesters)

There is a separate passing minimum of 40% for the external and overall components. Distribution of marks between external and internal assessments is:

- ♦ Passing minimum for external is 50% and the total passing minimum including external and internal is altogether 50% For Internal marks, the split up is 15 marks for test, 5 marks for seminar and 5 marks for Assignment. The average of the best two tests out of the 3 tests has to be taken as test mark.
- ♦ For project valuation 75 marks are maximum for internal and 75 marks are maximum for external and thereby the total maximum for project valuation is 150. For Viva maximum is 50. The Grand total of maximum for project+Viva Voce is 200 marks.

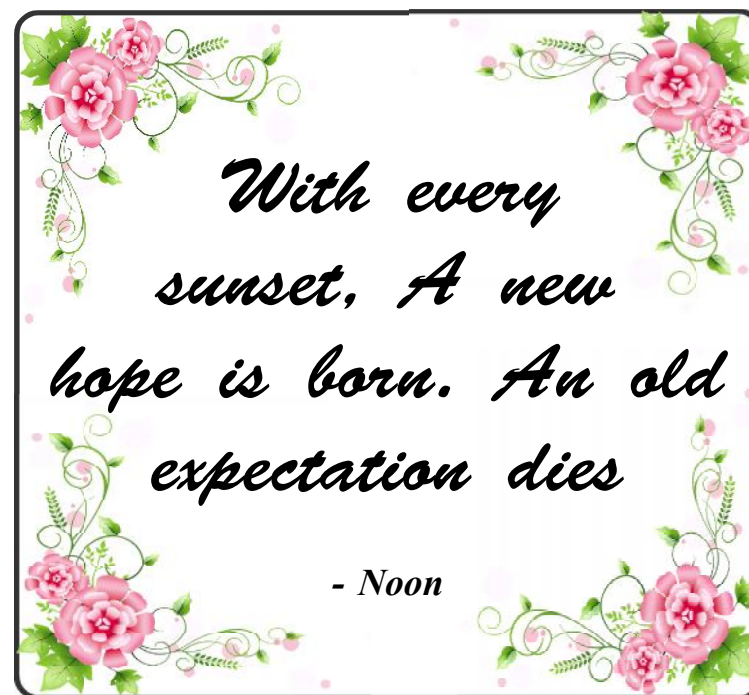

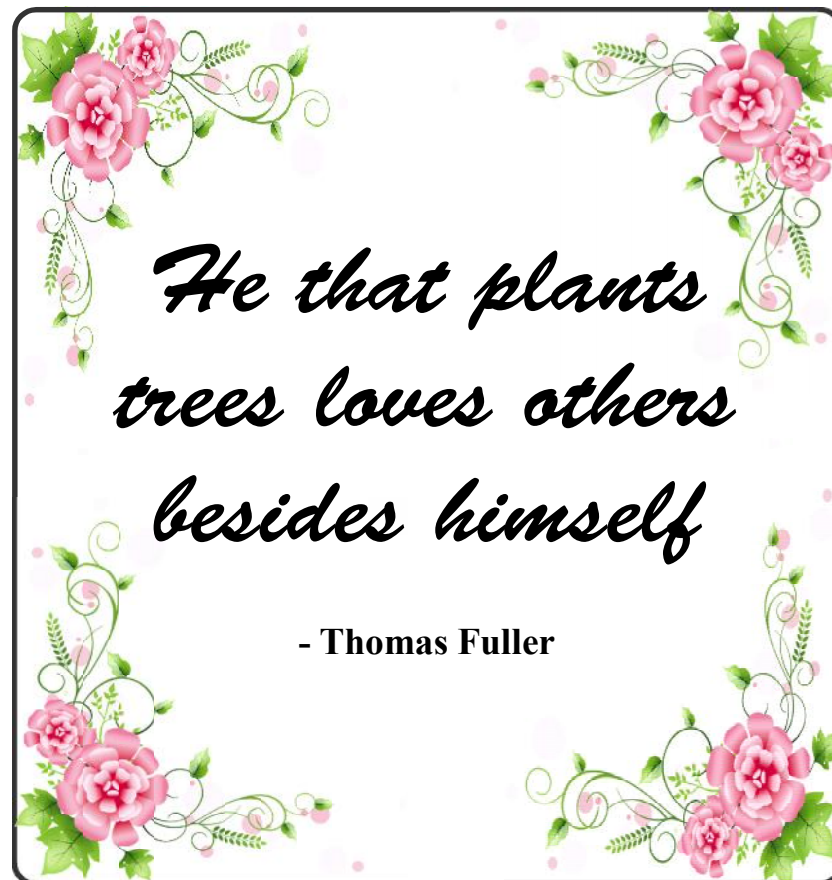

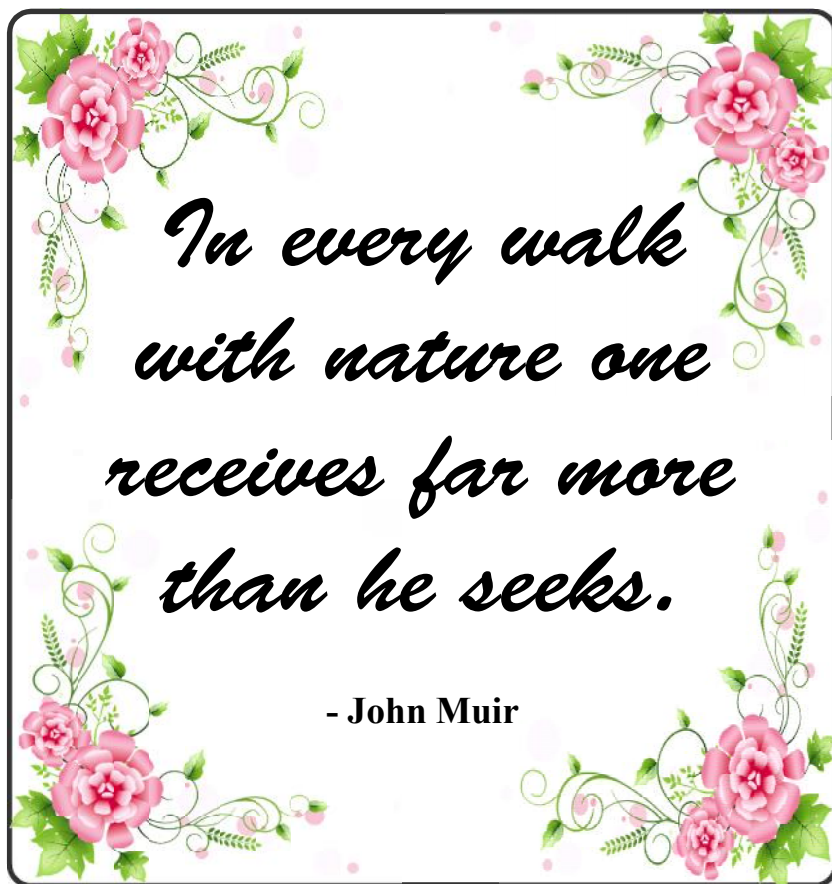

College Rules and Regulations

Rules For Admission

Application must be made in the Prescribed form obtained from the College. Two Photo copies of the following certificates should be submitted along with the filled in application form.

- * Higher Secondary or equivalent marks statement for U.G. course
- * B.A. /B.Sc./B.Com./BBA Mark statement for P.G. course
- * M.A/M.Sc./M.Com. mark statement for M.Phil. course
- * Community Certificate
- * Transfer Certificate
- * Conduct Certificate

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR LEAVE

1. All the applications of leave of domestic nature must be applied in the prescribed form obtained from the college countersigned by parent or guardian and handed over to the class tutor.
2. Any excuse of skipping classes, students should get permission from the H.O.D.
3. In case of long absence due to sickness, production of medical certificate is a must.

LIBRARY RULES

The following rules are meant for the benefit of all :

1. Strict silence must be observed within the Library and Reading Room.
2. Request for books must be made on printed slips which are available at the library on payment of a nominal fee.

3. Request slips should be dropped in the box provided for, before 10.00 a.m. so that the books may be issued between 1.00 p.m. and 4.00 p.m.
4. Book will be issued only on presenting the borrower's identification card.
5. Each student is allowed to borrow only one book at a time.
6. No one is allowed to either sub-lend the library book or get book on behalf of others.
7. The borrower is held responsible for any damage to the book he / she borrows. At the time of issue, the student should check and satisfy himself / herself that the book issued to him / her are in good condition.
8. The loss of any book should be reported at once to the Librarian.
9. In case a book is lost, the cost of the book with fine should be paid at the office.
10. Book must be returned to the library on or before the due date; if not a fine of 1 Rupee per day from the due date will be collected.
11. Reference books and periodicals should be read only in the Library or Reading Room and must not be taken out. After use they must be returned to the library - assistant in person.
12. The Librarian can recall a book even before the due date.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- The practitioner should maintain punctuality.
- The practitioner must be in the field with proper jersey or sport suit neat and tidy.
- The practitioner has to maintain discipline in the field and outside the field.

- The practitioner should behave with others with sportive spirit and sportsmanship.
- The practitioner must sign in and take sports materials and sign out after replacing it.
- Sports persons should follow regular practice with the coach and Physical Director.
- Sports persons are expected to maintain regular attendance for the classes and for the practice sessions.
- Sports persons should be found under the control of the Physical Director and everything has to be communicated to him or discussed with him.

COURSE CERTIFICATE

Course Certificate shall not be issued to students unless they show progress during the year by their regularity of attendance, diligent application to class work, and securing the required percentage of marks in various tests.

A student must attend college not less than three fourth of the working days and complete the course of study prescribed.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. All the students should obey the rules of the college.
2. Students shall handle all college properties with care and endeavour to preserve cleanliness and tidiness of the college campus including buildings and furniture.

3. When they meet any of the staff members or the members of the management, they must greet them.
4. When a staff member enters the class room, all the students shall stand up and remain standing till they are asked to sit down. Likewise, they should stand up while the staff member leaves the class.
5. No student is allowed to loiter inside the campus during the class hours.
6. Students are expected to move quickly when they move from one class to another and if they have no class they should go to library and observe strict silence.
7. While attending meetings or seminars, students should maintain strict silence and should listen to the speeches and avoid leaving during the meeting.
8. As per govt. rule Eve-teasing and ragging are considered as serious offence. Immediate action will be taken by the Principal as per the law in force.
9. The Principal has the full power to give punishment like fine, suspension or dismissal depending on the gravity of the misconduct.
10. The Principal has the right to issue Transfer certificate to any student at any time during the course of study for reasons of indiscipline, lack of progress in studies or illness considered to be confagious.
11. The misconducts such as irregular attendance, non co-operation to teachers, use of unpleasent words will be taken serious note of.
12. Students shall maintain strict silence while attending to lectures in the class room or working in the laboratories or attending meetings in the auditorium.

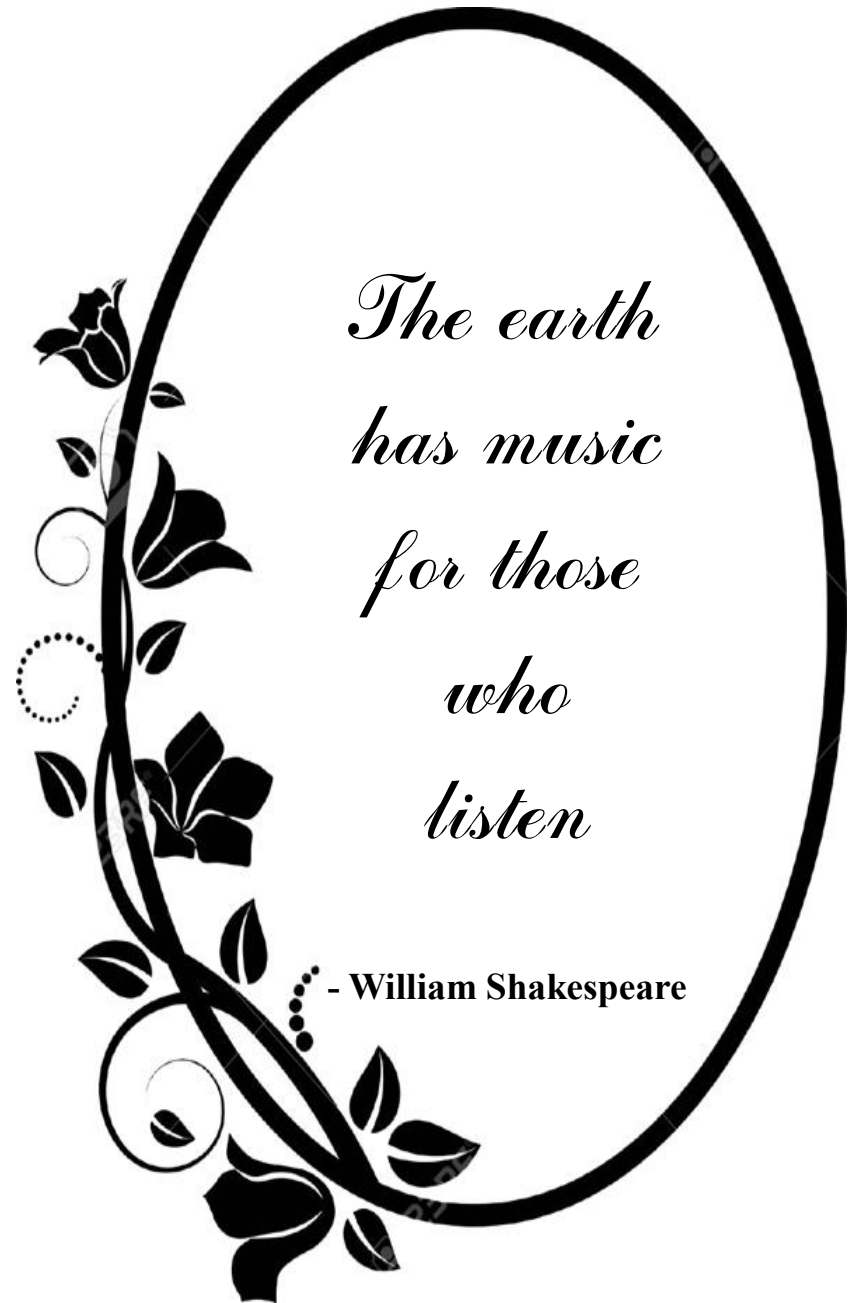
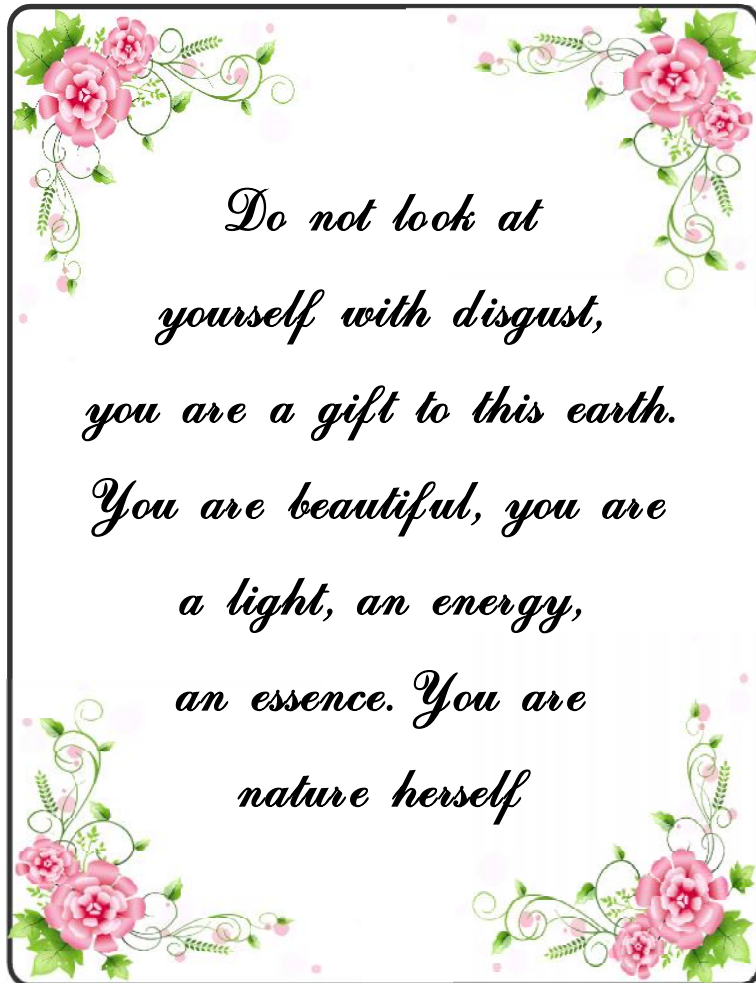
13. All changes of residential address and phone numbers should be reported to the office immediately.

16. Participation in parties or communal politics is strictly restricted inside the college campus.
17. Usage of cell phones within the class room and college premises is strictly prohibited.
18. Fees and fines must be paid only in the college on or before the fixed date.
19. Every Student should attend classes in full uniform with identity card.
20. Wearing T.shirts and caps are strictly prohibited inside the campus.

ATTENDANCE

- Every student shall attend the college regularly and punctually on all working days.
- The first bell is rung five minutes before the beginning of the morning and afternoon sessions and the remaining at the hour fixed for the beginning of each class.
- Before the first bell of each session students should go to their respective classes and take their seats quietly.
- Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each class hour. A student who is not present in the class when attendance is marked shall lose attendance for the session.
- Each academic year consists of two semesters of 90 days

each. Students without 75% of total attendance per semester are not allowed to write the university examinations. Those who put up 60% to 74% attendance will be allowed to write the examinations on payment of condonation fees.

- If a student is absent for one or more hours either in the morning or in the afternoon session he/she shall lose half a day attendance.

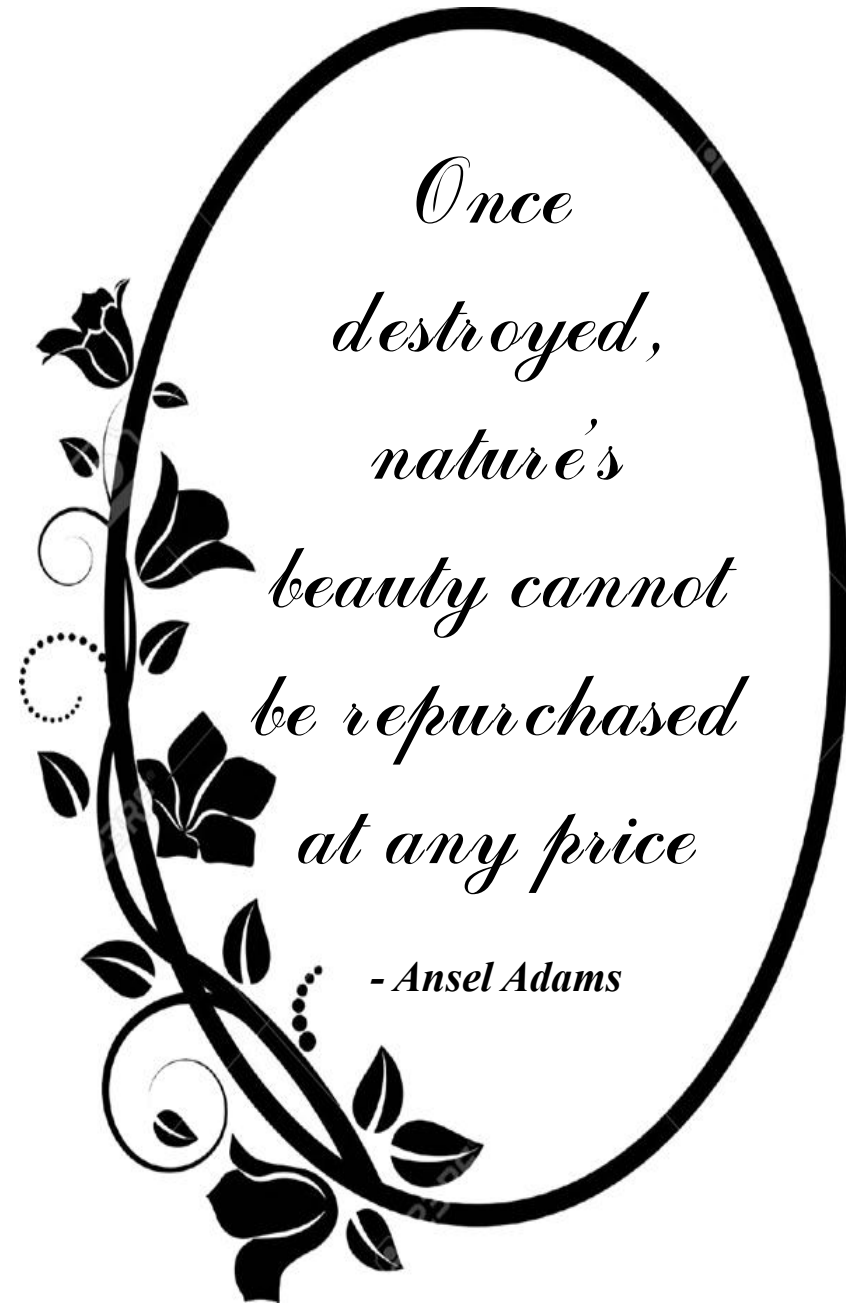
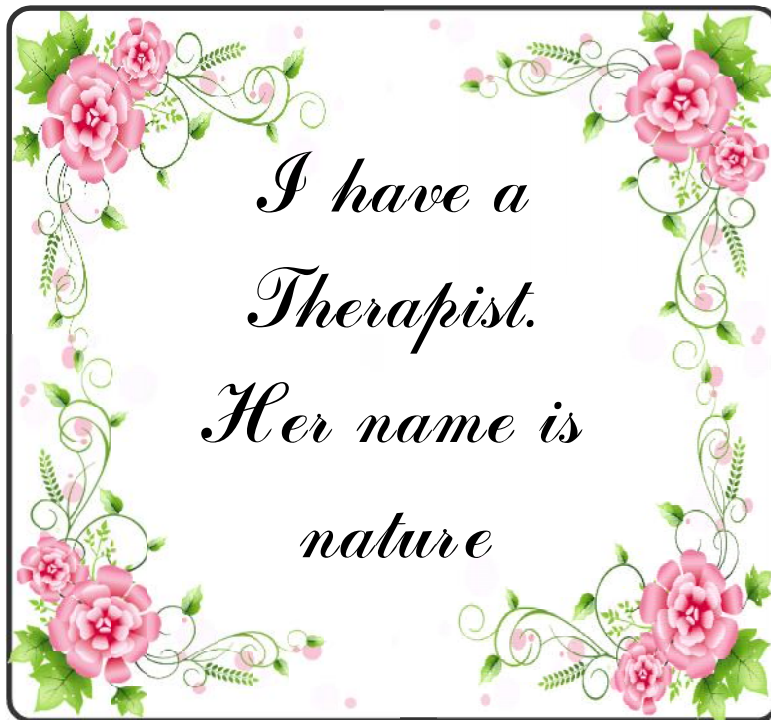

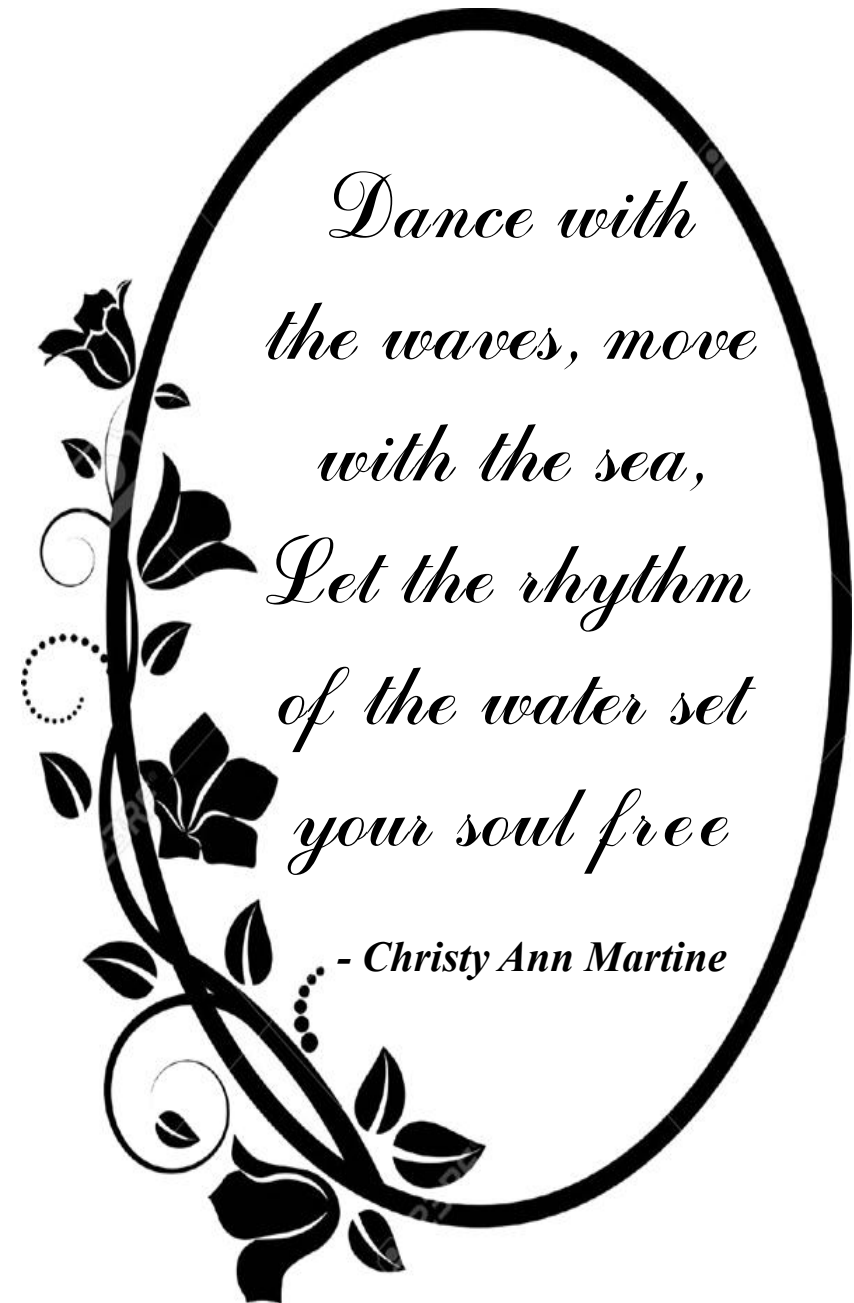
